The doctoral programme examines exchange processes between different denominations in the Early Modern Period (16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> century) in Germany and other European and non-European areas (especially Italy, England, Greek Orthodox areas, South America and China). Of particular interest are projects on theological, political, literary and artistic phenomena, which cross denominational boundaries (interconfessional) or demonstrate underlying confessional similarities (transconfessional).

Applicants should be open to media-historical questions on the impact of different confessional concepts on various artefacts as well as variations of theological ideas in art and their reception. Our aim is not only to examine how literature, theatre, painting, sculpture and church music represented confessional dogma, but also how they transformed the latter.
